Package includes: Analysis and review of your company's potential business and legal risk exposures, based on questionnaire responses. Up to 1.5 hours of attorney time to review the questionnaire responses and discuss your business' particular operations. A summary, written report provided to your company based on the questionnaire responses and follow up discussions. Conditions: Services shall be initiated within 90 days of the date of the letter of engagement.
